GOSPEL COMMENTARY 9/8 - Some saints, such as Irenaeus, Clement, Ambrose, and Origen, taught that Jesus was the Good Samaritan, and that the wounded man represented all of humanity. The priest and Levite represented the Old Testament ministers who could not save people from their sins. The Samaritan's actions, such as binding the wounds, anointing the man with oil and wine, and carrying him to an inn, represented Jesus saving people from spiritual death. Origen comments Jesus cared for the wounded "not only during the day, but also at night".
