TODAY – And for all of May we use the 1<sup>st</sup> Eucharistic Prayer on p. 77.

**POLISH PARADE** – The parade for Polish Constitution Day takes place today! St. Mary’s will be marching in the parade. Wear a St. Mary’s shirt! – please consider marching with us! The parade begins at 2pm and we ask that marchers arrive at the Parma Circle before then, just in case we head out early.

**EASTER** – The Easter Season begins with the Resurrection of Jesus on Easter Sunday and lasts 50 days, until the day of Pentecost, this year on May 19. The length of the celebration reminds us of the importance of this season and the importance of the Resurrection event in the story of our salvation. Please keep your Easter spirit strong over these next few weeks, as we remain standing throughout the Canon/Eucharistic Prayer of the Mass, as we add extra “alleluias” throughout the liturgy, and as our lilies and Easter decorations stand out in our church proper.
